## SOUTH COAST

(FROM OCTOBER TO APRIL)

Stretching out along a great arc of sunny coastline from Kirinda to Hambantota, there are some of the best-known Sri Lankan beaches including Jungle Beach, Unawatuna, Weligama, Mirissa, Tallala, and Tangalle. One of the greatest attractions of the South Coast cruises is the opportunity to experience the world's largest mammal, the Blue Whale, along with many other species of whales and dolphins. Onshore visits include the UNESCO world heritage city of Galle Fort, the ancient Dondra Lighthouse at the southernmost point of Sri Lanka as well as turtle and migrant bird conservation projects. What's more, unforgettable sunrises and sunsets are also a highlight of our southern cruises.

## WEST COAST

(FROM OCTOBER TO APRIL)

Get firsthand experience of emerging Colombo. Colombo is the capital city of Sri Lanka, and the country's largest city in terms of population. Located on the west coast, it is a beautiful city surrounded by white sand beaches and an impressive harbor front. Colombo is characterised by a series of canals, with the picturesque 160-acre Beira Lake at its center Colombo City Marina provides the perfect setting for investor meet-ups, workations, or adrenaline-pumped adventure water sports such as minibee sailing. Enjoy sailing the crystalline warm waters of the financial capital while the ever evolving Colombo skyline in your background.



## NORTH COAST

(FROM OCTOBER TO APRIL)

The North and its islands are a world away from the rest of the country, it is in many respects, Sri Lanka's last frontier. The city of Jaffna has a unique identity shaped by Portuguese, Dutch, British, Sinhalese, and Muslim influences on its predominantly Tamil cultural history. The once vibrant town offers a glimpse into a revival with its colorful temples set next to huge churches and streets of old colonial charm. Here, it is a must-not-miss experience to indulge in the gastronomic food and flavours that are unique to this region. In Palk Bay, west of Jaffna, a string of largely uninhabited islands offers the visitor the experience of the traditional lifestyle of these people. The trip to the North and cruising the islands is enhanced by the pleasure of reaching such remote and little visited parts of Sri Lanka.

## EAST COAST

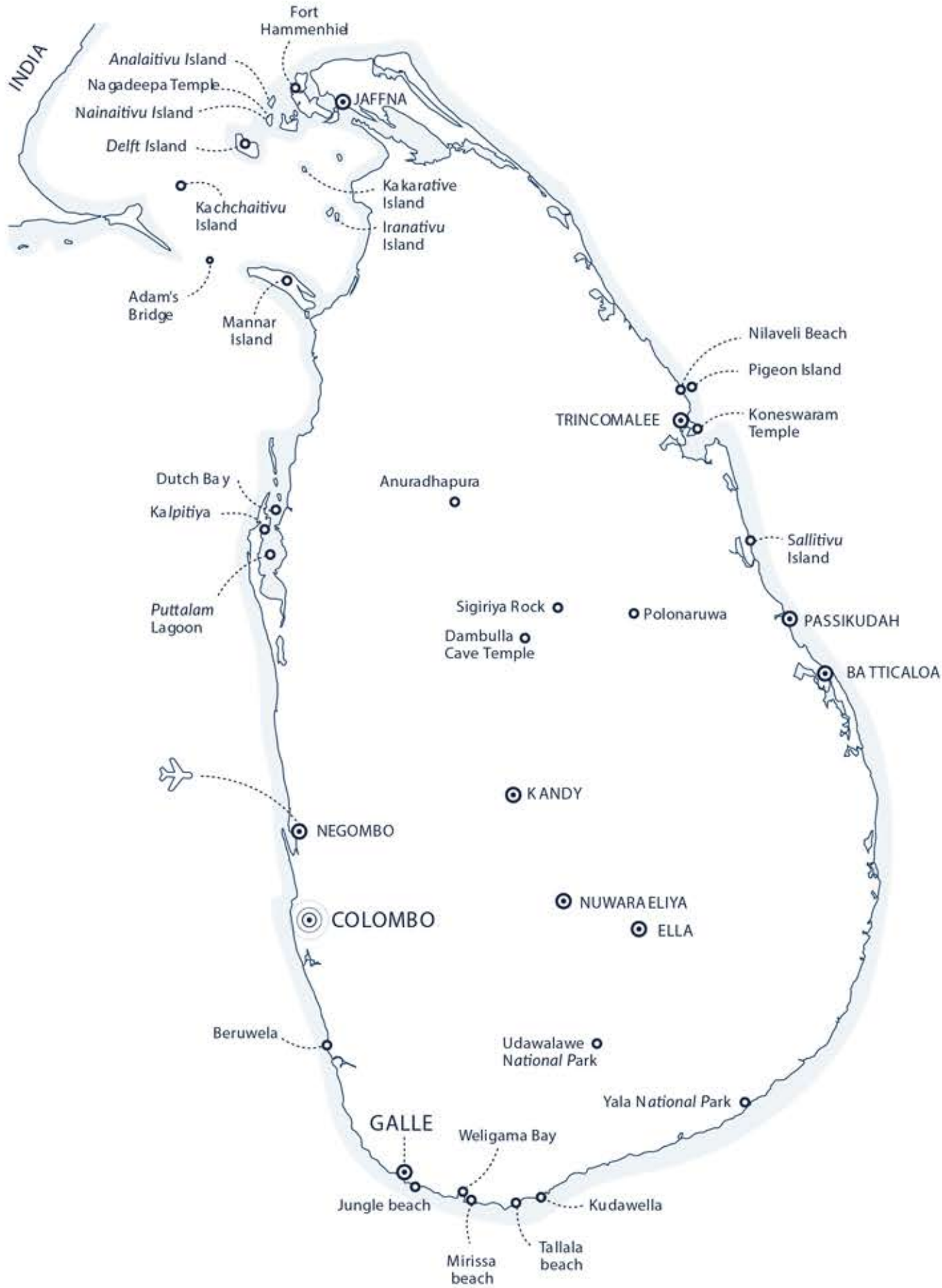
(MAY TO OCTOBER)

The extensive East coastline offers vast unexplored golden beaches, a perfectly laid back setting for travelers looking to step off the beaten path. You will discover the seaside port of Trincomalee, with its magnificent harbour, the coastal resort of Nilaveli with its calm and clear blue water, and the popular resort bay of Pasikuda with splendid coral reefs underneath the tranquil sea which is ideal for snorkeling and swimming. The coastline is dotted with lesser known heritage sites and places of spiritual significance. The lagoons and inlets of the East with their water bird life and mangroves provide a different type of water experience. Furthermore, the south lies the internationally famous surfing hotspot of Arugam Bay.

### DAY 1 - Welcome on board

Board at 4 pm in the picturesque and colorful Mirissa Fisheries Harbour. A short cruise, takes guests into the stunning Weligama Bay, where they can relax with a dinner on board under the stars.

### DAY 2 - Dutch Fort of Galle

Breakfast on board. Our captain sets sails to Jungle beach, in Galle. Guests can take a dinghy to the beach and crew will arrange for a walking

tour of the Dutch colonial fort city of Galle recognised as an UNESCO World Heritage. Dinner and night anchorage near Jungle beach.

### DAY 3 - Sailing towards Tallala

After a good breakfast, sail towards Talalla. Swim, sun bathe on the beautiful Talalla beach. Optional visit of a local fish or fruit market. Diner and night at Tallala beach.

### DAY 4 - Day at Kudawella

Breakfast on board followed by sailing towards the yet virgin and preserved beaches of Kudawella. Visit to local fisheries villages and temples can be organised. Lunch on board followed by a relaxing swim and a stand up paddle boarding session. Fish or seafood dinner under the stars.

### DAY 5 - Tangalle golden beaches

After breakfast, and a good swim, we sail toward Tangalle and Dickwella. On shore option of being taken by dinghy to Hiriketiya and Mawella beaches for a relaxing walk or a good swim in the warm tropical waters.



### DAY 6 - Whale watching

Early departure towards the coast of Dondra and Mirissa to observe the many species of Whales, including the world's largest Mammal the Blue Whale and playful dolphins of the Indian Ocean. Breakfast and lunch are served during the cruise. Afternoon in the relaxing beach of Mirissa for a swim, a stand up paddle boarding session or a surf session.

### DAY 7 - Return to Mirissa harbour

Boat returns to Mirissa Fisheries harbour at 10am after breakfast

### DAY 1 - Sail in Koddiyar Bay, Trincomalee

Board Dutch Bay, Trincomalee at 4 pm. Sail in the Magnificent Koddiyar Bay, taking in the dramatic coastline with the ancient Koneswaram temple perched high on the hill, enjoy a stunning sunset drink with dinner onboard. Guests can swim, canoe and enjoy stand up paddleboarding. Night at Back Bay, under the Koneswaram temple.

### DAY 2 - Sallitivu

Morning snorkeling, followed by breakfast. Sail past Trincomalee in search of dolphins

for 3 hrs. Arrive at Elephant Rock, at the entrance to Trincomalee Harbour at midday for lunch on board followed by snorkeling and stand up paddle boarding. Sail to Sallitivu Island (1h30). Arrival at sunset for dinner and night at anchorage.

### DAY 3 - Water Activities at Passikudah Bay

Sail south passing vast swathes of palm fringed deserted beaches, to arrive at the jewel of Passikudah Bay. A haven for all types of water activities, including snorkeling. Lunch on board.

### DAY 4 - Snorkeling at Ilantattunu

Sunrise swim in Passikudah followed by breakfast. Departure for Ilantattunu point for snorkeling and stand up paddle sessions. Lunch on board and departure for Lankapatuna. Arrival at Lankapatuna for sunset for a swim and dinner.

### DAY 5 - Kuchchaveli

Early breakfast and on shore exploration of the area known as jungle beach. Aquatic activities such as stand up paddle boarding, and swimming. Lunch on board. On Shore visit the beach followed by a special seafood dinner under the stars.



### DAY 6 - Pigeon Island Coral Reef National Park, Nilaveli

Departure after breakfast towards Nilaveli (1h30), viewing whales and dolphins on the way. Lunch off the coast of the Pigeon Island and guests can snorkeling off the magical pigeon island coral reef.

### DAY 7 - Return to Back Bay

Early swim and breakfast at Back Bay Short sail to disembarkation at Dutch Bay in Trincomalee by 10 am.

### DAY 1 - Welcome onboard

Board in Kurikkaduwan Jetty (40 min from Jaffna town) at 4 pm. The captain welcomes guests, and sets sail at sunset in front of Nanaitivu Island and its wonderful temples.

### DAY 2 - Nagadeepa

Breakfast on board while sailing to islands of Analathivu for relaxed swimming and Eluvathivu for an onshore visit. Lunch on board near Eluvaitivu. Afternoon sail to Nainaitivu (1h). Visit of the island and the famous Nagadeepa Viharaya and Nagapooshani Amman Temple.

### DAY 3 - Delft island

Early breakfast with a 9 am departure for 2 hour sail to Delft island. A local guide will share the history of this unique island famous for its Dutch history, coral walls and wild miniature horses. Local seafood lunch on Delft island. Swim in waters off the coast of Delft island and return to the yacht for dinner.

### DAY 4 - Onshore Trip to Jaffna/ Traditional Lunch

After breakfast, on shore exploration of the archeological site of Jaffna Fort with a guide. Visit to the Nallur Temple and artisanal woodcraftsman village. Followed by a traditional lunch in a Tamil home. Explore exquisite Hammenheil Fort and return to anchorage and dinner on board.

### DAY 5 - Adam's Bridge

Breakfast on board will be followed by a departure towards Talaimannar. Guests will visit Adam's Bridge, a unique formation of a chain of limestone shoals and a mythical bridge connecting India and Sri Lanka and Talaimannar Pier. Return to anchorage for swimming. Dinner on board at Talaimannar.



### DAY 6 - Kakarative Island

Breakfast and early morning sailing towards Kakarative. Onshore visit of the tiny island inhabited only by migrant fisherman and migrant sea birds. Guests can snorkel in the regenerating reef. Lunch onboard and departure for Nainaitivu. Arrival at sunset to sail in front of the Nagadeepa Temple. Dinner on board.

### DAY 7 - The end

After breakfast, guests will disembark at 10 am, at Kurrikaduwan Jetty (40 min from Jaffna town).








## CEYCAT 53' RANGE

The CEYCAT is designed to accommodate 8 to 12 guests accompanied by a Captain, Chef, and Crew members for overnight cruises. Where each of the four comfortable cabins contains a private bathroom with toilet.

The catamaran is equipped with all the navigation and communication equipment found on larger vessels and comes complete with water toys and a tender to take guests to the best snorkeling sites.

The front of the boat has a comfortable trampoline for sun-tanning. This is also the perfect spot to relax and enjoy the vast views of the coastline and open ocean during sailing.

Down the stairs on both left and right, you enter the boat's hulls. In the front are two spacious cabins. A third cabin and the crew's quarters are located the rear.

Two modern toilets are available in one of the hulls. A comfortable ladder in the front of the boat provides guests with easy access for swimming and snorkeling



## TOPAZ 48'

The deck has an open cockpit with cozy benches and cushions. In this shaded area we also provide foldable teak chairs and tables. The large sundeck offers a trampoline for reclining and sun tanning. And the bow has seats from which to enjoy the view of the gorgeous coastline.

The port side hull has a fully furnished kitchen iceboxes for chilled drinks. The starboard side hull has two bathrooms for ladies and gentlemen. Both have automatic toilets and sinks with running fresh water. Each hull has a cabin which is reserved for the crew.

The minibee brand sailboats were designed by Sabrosa in France and developed and manufactured in Sri Lanka using the most advanced boat building technologies. The first model was based on the min transat 6.5 m class. Powerful, fast and fun to sail.

## SAFETY FIRST

- The yachts are inspected by certified naval architects and issued with a seaworthiness certificate
- The catamarans are designed and built according to international standards.
- All Captains have Coxswain license, Yacht Master, Master of yachts or Captain 200 certificate
- More than 80% of the crew has a coxswain license or CDC license along with First Aid and Firefighting courses
- There are minimum 2 crew members on-board of which one is a certified lifeguard
- There are life jackets for all passengers and crew available in different sizes
- There are fire equipment available on board of every yacht
- Each boat is equipped with standby dinghy and rescue buoys.
- There is a standby high-speed RIB boat on shore in every base.
- Communication is done through VHF and mobile phone with staff on shore, the Navy and the coast guard. We have direct line with the operation room of the navy and the coast guard. Routes are communicated on daily basis to the navy and the coast guard.
- There is an emergency contact list on-board: Navy, coast guard, hospitals, ambulance service, doctors, transport
- Sail Lanka has a comprehensive insurance covering boat, passengers and third party.



## THE ORIGIN

Sail Lanka is an adventure initiated by a visionary man, Pierre Pringiers, who following the 2004 Tsunami, decided to dedicate his life to ocean based economic development through developing a yachting industry in Sri Lanka. It all started with a post-tsunami reconstruction project which benefited 15,000 people on the south coast of Sri Lanka. The Solideal Loadstar Rehabilitation Trust (SLRT), project was financed by its trustees (the Pringiers and Jinasena families), by large donor agencies and generous individuals.

The SLRT project was recognised by the UNHCR as the "best housing construction project" after tsunami. In 2006 Pierre Pringiers and his partner Dr Tissa Jinasena created the Building A Future Foundation (BAFF), that aim at improving the living condition of vulnerable people who depend on the resources of the ocean for their livelihood through capacity building, empowerment and economic self-sufficiency.





## CREATING VALUE AND SOCIAL ECONOMY FOR PEOPLE

Sail Lanka is a spin-off of the Building A Future Foundation (BAFF). Sail Lanka was set up to create and promote sailing as a new eco-friendly activity on the island.

Sail Lanka is a part of the Sea Leisure Yachting Group that aims at globally developing the yachting industry in Sri Lanka from boat building, sails and masts making to mini-marina creation, chartering services and sailing schools.

The development of this new economy will create new jobs and opportunities for the local youth in sustainable socio-economic industries related to the ocean



## SAILING AND YOUTH

The Ruhunu Sailing Association (RSA) is a non-profit organization that was setup at the initiative of BAFF with the objective to introduce sailing as a sport for youth from Tsunami effected areas of south.

Once they have developed a passion for sailing and an awareness of the marine treasures of the seas and shores around Sri Lanka, they will have the required skills and knowledge for employment in coastal activities and to become responsible, trained and ecologically sensitive professionals.

RSA provides (free of charge) intensive sailing courses to children on weekends in Mirissa
